Imagine being embraced by a Siberian storm while contemplating the cosmos - that's the electrifying impact these songs deliver. A standout, "Prophetic Mercury Implement", offers a fervent glimpse into their musicianship, promising an aural journey that's as profound as it is raw. From the melodic "I am Coin, I am Two" to the relentless drive of "The Fire in Which We Burn", this itinerary navigates the delicate balance where shadows kiss the dawn
