HELLS HEADBANGERS is proud to reissue MORTICIAN's cult-classic fourth full-length album "Darkest Day of Horror," on jewel case CD, featuring a blue disc and an 8-page booklet with a refreshed layout overseen by the band.

MORTICIAN returned in 2002 with Darkest Day of Horror, a record that captures the duo at one of their most confident and punishing peaks. From the moment the first cold sample flickers to life, it becomes obvious that the band is not interested in reinventing their formula. Instead, they sharpen it, thicken it, and deliver a barrage that feels even more relentless than their earlier assaults. This album exists as a celebration of everything MORTICIAN fans come to these releases for: crushing riff cycles, subterranean vocals that rumble like an awakening crypt, and the unmistakable presence of classic horror ambience.

What sets this particular record apart is the sense of momentum that runs through it. The songs feel more focused, firing off bursts of hypercharged rhythm drums and detuned guitar grind with a confidence that suggests the band knew exactly what they wanted to capture. When each track hits its stride, the sound becomes a wall of rumbling distortion that still manages to carve out memorable patterns beneath the chaos. It results in an approach that is utterly faithful to their legacy while giving listeners longer stretches of uninterrupted heaviness. For fans who crave MORTICIAN's most forceful material, this album stands tall.

The samples play a familiar but effective role, setting scenes that pull listeners deeper into the horror themes that have always fueled the band's identity. MORTICIAN uses them like a framing device that prepares the listener for whatever gruesome burst of violence is about to erupt. Once the music drops in, the record locks into its signature attack, bringing forward riffs that feel weighty and grim in all the right ways. Tracks like the title piece and the closing sequence of the album showcase the group's ability to turn simplicity into something hypnotic and crushing.

MORTICIAN has always been a band that inspires unwavering loyalty from the initiated, and Darkest Day of Horror rewards that devotion effortlessly. It is not a gateway release meant to convert the skeptical. Instead, it feels like a gift to the listeners who already love the band for exactly what they are. The album proves that consistency can be a strength, especially when delivered with this much conviction and extreme heaviness. For fans of MORTICIAN, this is a standout entry in their catalog, one that proudly embodies their grisly aesthetic in its purest form.
